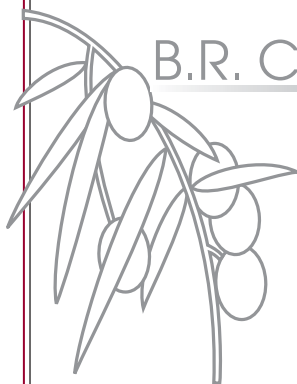
Olive Hill Estate Vineyards

Founded by Bruce Cohn in 1984, B.R. Cohn Winery is located in the heart of Sonoma Valley. This small family-operated winery is surrounded by the 90-acre Olive Hill Estate Vineyards, where soils warmed by underground natural hot springs and gentle ocean breezes create a unique microclimate, resulting in ideal growing conditions for Cabernet Sauvignon. B.R. Cohn also produces Chardonnay from the Carneros region and Merlot and SyrCab from Sonoma Valley.

In addition to its award-winning wines, B.R. Cohn makes world-class California gourmet Olive Oils and hand-crafted Vinegars. The Estate Olive Oil is crafted from 140-year-old French Picholine olive trees imported from France in the mid 1800s, which surround the estate.

Since founding the winery, Bruce Cohn's focus has been to create wines that emphasize balance, elegance and consistent high quality from vintage to vintage.

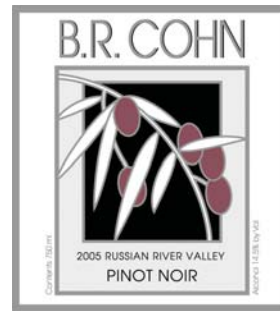

2005 RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

The 2005 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is produced from the finest vineyards in this appellation. It is a complex, lush wine with aromas of black cherry, raspberry and strawberry intermingled with a bouquet of vanilla, caramel and spice. It is rich and smooth on the palate with a lasting finish.



Our 2005 Pinot Noir was aged for 19 months in only the finest French Burgundy barrels. In order to help preserve the wine's natural character, we did not filter it prior to bottling.

While B.R. Cohn Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is a pleasure to enjoy on its own, it will also fare well with a wide range of entrees, complementing dishes such as lamb, duck or grilled salmon.
