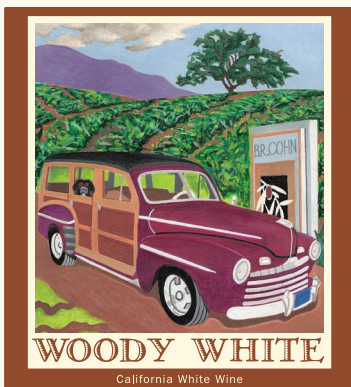


B.R. COHN WINERY

Shipped new to Manila in the Philippines in 1946 and residing there until 1986, this Woody served as a U.S. Embassy car after WWII.

Restored by Local craftsmen in the Philippines using Philippine mahogany, this Woody has been repainted and now has an updated engine, transmission and suspension. Disc brakes, power steering and air conditioning have also been added. It drives like a brand new car, with the exception of a few squeaks in the wood doors.
